S1: What's your favorite toy or game in your childhood?

S2: Do you prefer to eat prepared food or food made by yourself?

S2: Do you like to be taught by experienced teachers or by new teachers?

S1: Talk about a subject that is important but you are not interested in. Explain why it is important and why you are not interested in it.

S2: Do you prefer to watch a movie in a theater or at home? Explain why.

S1: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? It is good for students to attend a university or college in a foreign country. Explain why.

S1: Describe a gift that you want to give to someone.

S2: Is it easier to be a teacher than to be a student?

S1: Describe your favorite teacher. Explain why you like him or her. Include reasons and details to support your response.

S2: Some people prefer to make decisions quickly. Others prefer to take their time. Which do you prefer and why? Use specific reasons and examples to support your response.

S1: Describe an activity that you enjoy doing together with your family. Explain why. Please include reasons and details in your response.

S2: Some people prefer to do shopping in large grocery stores or department stores. Others prefer to do shopping in small grocery stores. Which do you prefer and why? Use specific reasons and examples to support your response.

S1: Describe a special friend in your childhood. Explain why this friend is special to you. Include reasons and details to support your response.

S2: Some people prefer to be a leader in a group project, while others prefer to be a supporting member in a group project. Which do you prefer and why? Use examples and details in your explanation.

S1: What skill (such as playing a sport, playing a musical instrument and speaking a foreign language) would you like to learn the most? Explain why.

S2: Some people prefer to attend team sports. Others prefer to do individual sports. Which do you prefer and why? Include details and examples in your explanation.

S1: Describe a time when you tried to do something that you have never done. Explain what you did and why you did it.

S2: Some people prefer to do one job or project at one time. Other people prefer to do several jobs or projects at the same time. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: What do you do to keep yourself healthy? Explain why it is important for you. Please include reasons and details in your explanation.

S1: Describe one of your friends. Explain how you met and became friends.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Personality changes as one grows older.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Children should be required to help with household tasks as soon as they are old enough to do so. Use specific reasons and examples to support your answer.

S1: Describe one thing you didn't want to do but you were asked to do. Explain what the result of that thing was. Include reasons and details in your response.

S2: Some people prefer to make detailed plans for the future. Others prefer to concentrate on present things and don't make any plans at all. Which way do you prefer? Use specific reasons to support your answer.

S1: What do you think is the most important quality of a working environment: good leaders, good colleagues, or flexible time?

S2: Do you agree or disagree: cell phone changes our lives greatly.

S1: Describe an interesting style of clothing in your country.

S2: Some people like to spend their spare time with friends, some people like to spend it alone. Which one do you prefer?

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the statement: artists and musicians are important to our society.

S1: Talk about one activity you will do in the near future. Explain why you want to do this activity.

S2: Some students take notes very often during class. Other students do not take notes or rarely take notes. Which do you think is better?

S1: Describe an important day in your life. Explain why it is important.

S2: Watching TV is not a good use of time. Do you agree or disagree?

S1: Describe a historical event that you're interested in most. Explain why you are interested in it and want to know more about it. Include reasons and examples to support your response.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? What a person wears can show his or her personality.

S1: Talk about an activity you enjoyed doing with your family when you were a child. Describe the activity and explain why it was enjoyable to do this activity with your family.

S2: Some students prefer to study or work on difficult class assignments early in the morning. Other students prefer to do this type of work in the evening. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: What suggestions would you like to give to a child who is starting school for the first time? Use reasons and specific examples to explain why these suggestions are important.

S1: Talk about a type of movie you do not like. Explain why you do not like this type of movie

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Students should do part-time jobs before attending college.

S1: Describe a period of time in your life that you enjoyed the most. Explain why.

S2: Do you prefer to listen to live music like concert, or do you prefer to listen to recorded music.

S1: Describe a special experience that has changed you in life. Give reasons why it changed you with examples/details

S2: Do you prefer to learn from current people and events or from people and events in the past?

S1: Describe a tool or object that you rely on often in your daily life. Explain why it is important to you. Include reasons and examples to support your response.

S2: Some people prefer to solve a challenge all by themselves. Others prefer to depend on other people's help. Which do you prefer and why? Include details and examples in your explanation.

S1: Which person do you want to know more about? Explain why.

S2: Do you like to go to one place and stay there for a long time for your vacation, or different places and spend little time at each place?

S1: If a foreign visitor comes to your country, what food will you introduce to him/her? Explain why.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Teachers should require students to participate in class discussion.

S1: Talk about an experience of learning something new. What difficulties do you have to overcome in order to learn it?

S2: Some people like to watch or listen to news every day while others do that occasionally. Which do you prefer and why? Use specific reasons and examples to illustrate your point.

S1: Where do you like to go shopping? Explain why. Include details and examples to support your response.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? It is important to study the history of our ancestors. Include details and examples to support your answer.

S1: What do you think is the most important advancement over the past 20 years in your country? Use reasons and specific examples to explain why you think that is important.

S1: Talk about a memorable experience you had in a restaurant or cafe. Explain what happened and why it was memorable. Give specific details in your response.

S2: Some people believe that a person needs to possess natural physical ability in order to be successful at sports. Others believe that any person can become successful at sports through hard work. Which do you agree with and why?

S1: Your friend often feels nervous when speaking in front of a large group of people. What suggestions would you give to your friend to overcome this fear?

S2: Do you prefer to have fast food in a fast-food restaurant, or do you prefer to have food in other kinds of places?

S1: Describe a skill you have that you want to improve. Describe the details of what you will do to improve it.

S2: Do you agree or disagree the following statement: Advertising has too much influence on what people buy.

S1: Describe a piece of news or a story that you are interested in recently. Explain why you think it was interesting. Include reasons and details in your response.

S1: Many schools do not allow students to take their laptop computers into the classroom. What do you think are the advantages and disadvantages of having laptop computers in the classroom? Use specific details and examples to support your opinion.

S2: Some people like to move about and live in different places. Others like to stay at one place all their lives. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: Describe two schools you have been to, and explain how they are different.

S1: If you are given an assignment, what would you do to make sure it is finished on schedule? Give specific details and examples to support your answer.
