S1: Describe your favorite room either of your own house or in other places and explain why.

S1: Among the following three professions, which do you think make the biggest contribution to society? Teachers, farmers, doctors.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following question. In order to stay happy, you must have a job that you love doing.

S1: Describe a day that you enjoyed the most or was the most special to you. Include reasons and details to support your response.

S2: Some people prefer to have classes during the day and do part-time jobs in the evening while others prefer to have classes in the evening and do part-time jobs during the day. Which do you prefer?

S1: Describe the changes in your life five years from now on. Include specific examples and details in your explanation.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Power and money is the symbol of success.

S1: What is your favorite outdoor place to do exercise in a nice day?

S2: Some people like to have a break or get a job during summer vacation. Others think it is better to take a class. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: Describe a most unforgettable success in your life. Explain why it was important to you. Include reasons and examples to support your response.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? It is never too late for an old person to receive higher education and to get a university degree. Use specific reasons to support your answer.

S1: What country or culture do you want to learn about the most? Explain why you want to learn about this country or culture.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Electronic books will not replace printed books.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? The most important lessons cannot be learned in classrooms.

S1: Describe a time when you tried to do something that you have never done. Explain what you did and why you did it.

S2: Some people prefer to do one job or project at one time. Other people prefer to do several jobs or projects at the same time. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: Describe one of your friends. Explain how you met and became friends.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Personality changes as one grows older.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Children should be required to help with household tasks as soon as they are old enough to do so. Use specific reasons and examples to support your answer.

S1: Describe one thing you didn't want to do but you were asked to do. Explain what the result of that thing was. Include reasons and details in your response.

S2: Some people prefer to make detailed plans for the future. Others prefer to concentrate on present things and don't make any plans at all. Which way do you prefer? Use specific reasons to support your answer.

S1: Describe a character in a book, film, or poem, and explain why you like it.

S1: Describe an interesting style of clothing in your country.

S2: Some people like to spend their spare time with friends, some people like to spend it alone. Which one do you prefer?

S1: If you were to become a volunteer at the school or in the community, what kind of volunteer work would you do and why?

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the statement: artists and musicians are important to our society.

S1: Talk about one activity you will do in the near future. Explain why you want to do this activity.

S2: Some students take notes very often during class. Other students do not take notes or rarely take notes. Which do you think is better?

S1: Describe an important day in your life. Explain why it is important.

S2: Watching TV is not a good use of time. Do you agree or disagree?

S1: Describe a historical event that you're interested in most. Explain why you are interested in it and want to know more about it. Include reasons and examples to support your response.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? What a person wears can show his or her personality.

S1: Talk about an activity you enjoyed doing with your family when you were a child. Describe the activity and explain why it was enjoyable to do this activity with your family.

S2: Some students prefer to study or work on difficult class assignments early in the morning. Other students prefer to do this type of work in the evening. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: What suggestions would you like to give to a child who is starting school for the first time? Use reasons and specific examples to explain why these suggestions are important.

S1: Talk about a type of movie you do not like. Explain why you do not like this type of movie.
S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Students should do part-time jobs before attending college.

S1: Describe a period of time in your life that you enjoyed the most. Explain why.
S2: Do you prefer to listen to live music like concert, or do you prefer to listen to recorded music.

S1: Describe a special experience that has changed you in life. Give reasons why it changed you with examples/details.
S2: Do you prefer to learn from current people and events or from people and events in the past?

S1: Describe a tool or object that you rely on often in your daily life. Explain why it is important to you. Include reasons and examples to support your response.
S2: Some people prefer to solve a challenge all by themselves. Others prefer to depend on other people's help. Which do you prefer and why? Include details and examples in your explanation.

S1: Which person do you want to know more about? Explain why.
S2: Do you like to go to one place and stay there for a long time for your vacation, or different places and spend little time at each place?

S1: Choose ONE of the forms of the technology in the list and tell why it has great impact on people's lives in your country? Airplane, computer or television. Use specific reasons and examples to support your response.
S2: Which is better for children? To grow up in a big city or to grow up in a small town?

S1: If a foreign visitor comes to your country, what food will you introduce to him/her? Explain why.

S1: Talk about an experience of learning something new. What difficulties do you have to overcome in order to learn it?
S2: Some people like to watch or listen to news every day while others do that occasionally. Which do you prefer and why? Use specific reasons and examples to illustrate your point.

S1: Where do you like to go shopping? Explain why. Include details and examples to support your response.

S1: What do you think is the most important advancement over the past 20 years in your country? Use reasons and specific examples to explain why you think that is important.

S2: Do you prefer an assignment that requires you to write a long essay, or an assignment that asks you to give a speech in front of the class?

S1: Talk about a memorable experience you had in a restaurant or cafe. Explain what happened and why it was memorable. Give specific details in your response.
S2: Some people believe that a person needs to possess natural physical ability in order to be successful at sports. Others believe that any person can become successful at sports through hard work. Which do you agree with and why?

S1 : Describe a person that you look up to as a role model. Explain how this person influenced your life. Include details and examples to support your response.
S2 : Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Young children should learn to draw or paint. Include details and examples to support your answer.

S1: Your friend often feels nervous when speaking in front of a large group of people. What suggestions would you give to your friend to overcome this fear?

S2: Do you prefer to have fast food in a fast-food restaurant, or do you prefer to have food in other kinds of places?

S1: Describe a piece of news or a story that you are interested in recently. Explain why you think it was interesting. Include reasons and details in your response.

S2: Some students prefer to take an essay question where they must write an essay to a question. Other students prefer to take a test with objective questions. Which type of exam question do you prefer? Give reasons and examples in your explanation.

S1: Among the following three types of professions, which do you think makes the most important contribution to society? Primary school teacher, nurse, artist.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? People who are 18 years old are not mature enough to vote.

S1: Our society is now facing very serious environment problems. Choose one approach that you believe to be useful to save our planet.

S2: Are you willing to carefully choose the gift which your friends like or choose whatever you like ?

S1: Among the following three types of books, which do you like the least? Mystery novel, science fiction, biography.

S2: Do you like to travel alone or travel with your family members? Explain why.

S1: Describe a good study habit you have that is different from other students.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Playing computer or video games has a negative influence on teenagers.

S1: What kind of music do you like the least? Give reasons why you do not like this kind of music.

S2: Some college students like to spend their free time studying another course or doing schoolwork. Others like to join a club and enjoy club activities. Which do you think is better and why?

S1: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? University students should learn how to manage their time more efficiently.

S2: Some people prefer to listen to music while they are studying or working. Others prefer to stay in a quiet place while they are studying or working. Which way do you prefer and why? Include reasons and details in your response.

S1: Many schools do not allow students to take their laptop computers into the classroom. What do you think are the advantages and disadvantages of having laptop computers in the classroom? Use specific details and examples to support your opinion.

S2: Some people like to move about and live in different places. Others like to stay at one place all their lives. Which do you prefer and why?

S1: Among the following three types of work, which would you enjoy doing the most? Helping children with communication problems, doing community work, growing plants in the garden.

S2: Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Watching sports programs on television is not a good use of time.

S1: If you are given an assignment, what would you do to make sure it is finished on schedule? Give specific details and examples to support your answer.

S2: Some people prefer outdoor activities such as basketball. Others prefer indoor activities such as yoga. Which would you prefer and why?
